

## **The Fake Fish-eye**

A “Bonus” assignment.

1. Choose one of your photos. Open it in photoshop.
2. Size it to reasonable dimensions. Make sure that your background is transparent.
3. Select the elliptical marquee tool. Hold down shift so that your selection remains a perfect circle. Be selective - only highlight parts of the picture that you really want to focus on.
4. Go to Select, in the top menu, and then choose Inverse. Delete this new selection. You will be left with just a circle.
5. Go to Filter, Distort, Spherize— you can alter the levels if you wish. Choose 100% normal (in most cases).
6. Find a new background that matches the foreground (Fish-eye).
7. Save the project as `firstname_lastname_fisheye.jpg`. Place it in your Final Photoshop Folder.
8. This will be a bonus assignment to improve your grade, or to replace a missing assignment. Plus fish-eye lenses are very costly...just think of the money you've saved...on a lense.
