

Green Screening

1. Find three large resolution pictures from Google images. Save them in your media folder. Choose images that you will be able to add yourself into.
2. Position yourself on the green screen. Take three photos of yourself that will be appropriate to merge into the three photos from the internet.
3. Open your green screen photos in Photoshop. Magic wand out as much of the green as possible.
4. Open the original photo – size it to an appropriate size: 4x6 is conventional.
5. Select the remainder of the photo (you), and place it into the original photo.
6. Save your new picture as a .jpg. Raise the resolution to high. Remember to put all finished items in your finished folder.

Tips

- Light the green screen as much as possible: you want a consistent colour.
- Have your partners pull the screen tight.
- Don't stand within a foot of the screen. This avoids shadows.
- When using the magic wand experiment with different tolerance levels that best capture all of the green.
- Make it look as realistic as possible.
