

## TGJ3M SUMMATIVE – MUSIC VIDEO

### Total Value 30%

#### Step 1 – Find Group Members

Find a group 3 or 4 people and choose a song for the subject of your summative.

After your group has selected a song, you need to print the lyrics and show them to Mr.Olson for approval. Use the radio edit.

#### Step 2 – Group name

Choose a name for your group.

#### Step 3- Photoshop 10%

**Each group member** will create a unique group logo in Adobe Photoshop. The dimensions must be 720 X 480 pixels at a resolution of 150 ppi.

**Each group member** will also create a unique front and back CD cover as well as a CD Stamp.

The CD stamp patterns can be found on Google. The resolution for the CD stamps will also be 150 ppi.

**Each group member** will create a unique advertising poster in Adobe Photoshop. The dimensions must be 11X14 inches at a resolution of 100 ppi. The poster should advertise the music video and song. Actors and other important information should be on the poster.

Grading will be done via the Graphic Design Rubric – as posted on the Wiki.

#### Step 4- Storyboard

Complete a group storyboard. You will need a new frame for each change of scene or camera angle. Submit the storyboard to Mr.Olson when you are done. I will copy it and hand it back. You will be marked against your completion of the storyboard.

#### Step 5- Film

Start filming! Be sure to use many angles and cuts. View exemplars prior to starting.

#### Step 6-Credits

**Each group member** will make a unique set of credits. It must be at least 3 seconds long.

#### Step 7- Edit

- Edit your film using Adobe Premier.
- **Each group member** will insert their unique set of credits in their version.
- You will need to include 4 scene divisions on your DVD.
- Credits must include names of all group members as well as their **individual logos**. Credits should also include editor, actor, etc.
- You also need to include your newly created **group logo** you designed for this project.
- You also need to include the following text: A TGJ3M Production. Filmed on location at Hillcrest

High School.

- In their own scenes, you need to include the CD cover front and back, movie poster, and the CD stamp.

### **Step 7- Save**

Save all of your individual work in your N:TGJ3M/Summative folder. (Daily)

You should have a group logo, cd stamp, cd cover front and back, video poster, and credits.

Save your film in your N: TGJ3M / Summative folder as: groupnamepsum.avi

Steps 4-7 = 20% - Graded via Video Rubric

Last Day of class will be a day where all films will be shown. Be Ready.

Burn your entire project on a DVD prior to exams.
