

TGJ3M –THE POWER OF SEPIA AND BLACK AND WHITE

Step 1: Take a picture of yourself on the greenscreen.

Step 2: Download your picture from the I:drive onto your N: drive.

Step 3: Goto google of flickr and research Sepia photos.

Step 4: Take your picture and put it onto a background of your choice. (I recommend finding a high quality photo of a famous place –Taj Mahal, Eiffel Tower, Macchu Picchu, Stonehenge, or a beach, mountain etc., or create a wanted poster).

Step 5: Put yourself into the picture.

Step 6: Photoshop the picture into Sepia or Black and White. (For B&W choose the ENHANCE menu, when that drops down, select “convert to Black and White”

Step 7: Play with the contrast, highlights etc. in Photoshop. Then compare your picture with what you saw in the Peter Leverman website.

STEP8: Save in your N:drive/digital photography folder as lastname_sepia.psd
