

## Pop Art Portrait

1. Take a photo of yourself; or a willing partner. Use the portrait lights to cast some shadow on your face. Contrast is the key.
2. Open the photo in photo shop. 4X4 resolution 200.
3. Select/mask the background. Go to Layer and create a new layer via cut. The background should now be on a new layer. You can now fill this layer with any colour that you wish.
4. Go back to the portrait layer. Go to Filters, then Adjustments, and then Threshold. You can alter the amount of threshold at this point.
5. Create a new layer. Fill it with a colour of your choice.
6. Select either the black or the white elements of the photo. Magic Wand then Select Similar. Delete this selection. You will now be able to see through to your background layer, thus giving this selection a new colour.
7. Fill the white or black (the selection that you did not use previously) with a new colour.
8. Repeat this sequence 3 more time and change the colours each time. Save each new version as a .jpg. Combine the 4 jpegs on one image that is 8x8.
9. Save the final image as **firstname\_lastname\_framing.jpg**
